And speaking of earrings, if you do opt for earlobe reduction surgery, rest assured you can wear your glittery baubles again. Even earlobes that have been

repaired can be re-pierced — just not in the exact same spot. Aim for a spot to the left or right, or at a point slightly higher or lower.

Renewed focal point

Why endure the results of gravity and aging? Rejuvenate your earlobes and dare to bare them once more. An earlobe repair procedure can also correct the aftermath of an earring mishap, such as a hoop catching in a sweater with a resulting lobe tear. It's also effective for reversing the result of large gauge piercing, if participants start rethinking their decision. Earlobes may be small, but they're a worthy asset!

~ Excision for Nasolabial Folds ~ A determined approach to a nagging, sagging problem

Does it seem like every time you look, the grooves alongside your nose have grown deeper? Nasolabial folds are a normal part of human

anatomy. The simple act of smiling etches these creases in over time. Sun exposure, loss of collagen and fat, and sometimes even ge-

netics play a role in determining how pronounced these so called "laugh lines" ultimately become.

There are a number of ways to diminish the appearance of nasolabial folds. A mini facelift can improve their appearance while it simultaneously lifts drooping cheeks. Dermal fillers are another solution. A professional injects filler just under the skin in the nasolabial fold area or in the mid-face region to give cheeks a lift. Either injection point

can make the unattractive creasing and sagging less noticeable. Dermal fillers' lasting power increases with each new

generation of products but they are still considered a temporary treatment for deep smile lines.

Power move

An alternative to a mini facelift or dermal fillers is surgical excision of deep, undesirable nasolabial folds. During this outpatient procedure, the smile lines are cut out along their entire length. The drooping cheek fat can then be slid under the fold and the skin edges carefully realigned with placement of key sutures (stitches) underneath. Dr. Timothy Jochen brings his renowned cosmetic eye surgery expertise to this procedure. His artful placement of dissolving sutures minimizes scarring in this very noticeable location. Scar lines are aligned so that they look much like a natural skin fold, the kind that is normally present. The exaggerated version is gone!

Lidocaine is used to numb the area at the start of this simple in-office procedure. It normally takes about an hour to complete. Patients return home

to recuperate with complete suture care instructions. They will likely experience a mild to moderate degree of soft tissue swelling and sometimes

mild bruising along the smile lines. These issues usually resolve themselves by the end of the first week and most patients feel quite presentable in approximately 7-10 days.

A permanent solution

It may sound daunting at first, but surgical excision can lead to a dramatic improvement of deep smile lines. The sagging and shadowing that so plagues some individuals can vanish in this

simple one-hour procedure. It's a powerful way to face the problem of prominent nasolabial folds head-on. It's more focused than a

mini facelift and certainly longer lasting than fillers.

If you're feeling defeated by the depth and prominence of your so-called "laugh lines," you owe it to yourself to consider surgical excision. Patients contemplating the procedure can count on Dr. Jochen's carefully-honed esthetic sense and practiced surgical hand to deliver the most natural-looking results.

This product is more commonly known as Retin A. Obagi Tretinoin comes in three strengths – 0.025%,

0.05% and 0.10%. It is available as a cream and gel. Aja prefers the gel formulation. "It's great for evening out your skin tone and texture and it helps rejuvenate the skin by increasing your collagen production. This product is also great for fighting acne and oily skin," she said.

Aja has a beautiful olive complexion, but her skin is slightly oily. She starts her day off with Contour Dermatology's Gly/Sal wash, which features a combination of glycolic acid and salicylic acid to control oil production.

Retin A should be applied only at night. It does make your skin a little more sun sensitive, so it's essential to apply sunscreen when you use this product, but you should be doing that anyway, right? Aja uses Obagi's Sunshield Matte Broad Spectrum Sunscreen SPF 50.

Retin A helps to improve acne by exfoliating the top layer of the skin, making it harder for bacteria and oils to build up. For anti aging, it speeds up the turnover of new cells to give you that fresh glow by increasing collagen production to help diminish existing fine lines and wrinkles and keep new ones at bay. Beyond an excellent cleanser and sunscreen, if you could only have one, anti-aging product in your skin care routine, Retin A would most likely be it, but, of course Contour has many physician grade products from which to choose. Even people with sensitive skin are usually able to tolerate the lowest strength of 0.025%. ~ A More Permanent Solution ~ Liposuction for Hyperhidrosis

Ever heard anyone say they were "sweating buckets"? They're usually exaggerating to prove a point, but what if excessive sweating were a daily occurrence? It's a fate that those who suffer from hyperhidrosis know all too well. An estimated 2-3% of Americans suffer from excessive sweating of the underarms (axillary hyperhidrosis) or of the palms and feet (palmoplantar hyperhidrosis). A neurologic, endocrine, infectious or other systemic disease

can cause hyperhidrosis, but more often than not cases develop in otherwise healthy people. Underarm problems tend to crop up in later adolescence while palm and sole sweating often begins earlier, typically at the onset of puberty. sweat glands are more widely dispersed, so a treatment like Botox is a better solution for excessive sweating in these areas.

The ins and outs of liposuction

Liposuction to treat axillary hyperhidrosis is an outpatient procedure usually performed under local anesthetic. A series of small incisions are made above and below the armpit at the start of proceedings. Then a small tube is inserted to suck

out the superficial layer of fat in the armpit where the sweat glands lie. A clean sweep is ideal except sweat glands are tiny and invisible by nature. It is therefore difficult to determine exactly how many sweat glands are being removed or damaged during the approximate 90-minute surgery. This can lead to varying results.



Addressing the problem

The first solution is to try to manage the problem with topical agents. When those don't work, some people turn to Botox. Yes, the injectable that has gained fame for its wrinkle-reducing abilities, can also successfully manage excessive underarm sweating. Typically, about 100 units in total of Botox are injected into roughly 20 to 25 spots in each armpit every six months. Galderma's Dysport is also an effective alternative to Botox.

But what if the problem could be solved once and for all? Liposuction offers that possibility. Best known as a fat removal procedure, liposuction can also effectively remove sweat glands permanently so they can no longer produce perspiration. It is able to do so because sweat glands are located just beneath the dermal surface where the skin and underlying fat meet. In the underarm area, sweat glands are also fairly localized, making surgery a viable option. In the palms and soles,

Upping the ante

To increase the odds of successfully eliminating more sweat glands, liposuction can be combined with either of two other techniques. One of those techniques is curettage meaning sweat glands are scraped out in conjunction with suction. The other technique involves using a laser to liquefy the tissue containing the sweat glands which liposuction can then remove.

A serious problem deserves a serious solution. If your underarm sweat quotient exceeds the normal amount required to maintain consistent body temperature, you're likely suffering from some degree of hyperhidrosis. When topical agents fail and the idea of two or three annual Botox treatments proves unappealing, liposuction just might be the answer. ~ What is Poikiloderma of Civatte and What Helps? ~ Excel V laser can banish annoying redness and "chicken skin"

Has your neck and/ or possibly your chest been exhibiting color changes? Has skin in those areas gained a "chicken-like" appearance? You could be experiencing Poikiloderma of Civatte. Don't worry — it's not as bad as it sounds. Usually the result of

long-term sun exposure, Poikiloderma of Civatte is a chronic, but benign skin condition that crops up in fair-skinned adults. The likelihood of its occurrence increases with age and it typically

affects women more frequently than men.

The pattern of skin changes you may have observed is characterized by areas of both hyperpigmentation (darker pigmented areas of skin) and hypopigmentation (areas of skin with less than normal pigment). The resulting mottled appearance is

further complicated by skin atrophy and spider vein formation. Sometimes the situation can turn quite dire and be a real source of embarrassment.

Fortunately, Poikiloderma does not pose any kind of health threat and requires no treatment other than to address the cosmetic concerns already implied. The good news is this condition responds very well to laser treatment and, of course, here at Contour, we offer excellent options.

A targeted effort

The same Excel V Laser that works wonders on vascular skin conditions such as rosacea and spider veins can reduce redness caused by Poikiloderma. As I already mentioned, telangiectasia (spider vein formation) is often a symptom of the

condition. Similar to rosacea, Poikiloderma presents as a diffuse redness, making it difficult to treat.

Miniscule networks of blood vessels require a very short pulse width to treat effectively — something the Excel V Laser system is capable of delivering. Its patented microsecond 1064 nm (nanometer) treatment is an excellent diffuser. At the same time, it serves as an excellent skin rejuvenation treatment. While it's targeting micro veins with microsecond high peak power pulses and reducing redness, it's also stimulating collagen production. It's a double win.

Patients report experiencing a stinging sensation as the pulses of light are delivered through the

hand piece. Otherwise, it's smooth sailing with no local anesthesia or pain mediation typically required. No downtime either.

Gone in a flash

Those vexing pigment changes plaguing your neck and chest can also be with treated with an intense pulsed light (IPL) device.

Similar to the flash of a camera, IPL passes through the top layer of the skin and penetrates to the deeper layers where blood vessels, pigment and collagen are found. Hyperpigmentation can become a thing of the past and, yes, this versatile, no-down-time laser is renowned for its skin rejuvenating properties as well.

Why let Poikiloderma of Civatte mar your neck and chest? Now that I've cleared up the mystery of those baffling color changes in these areas, let's see if we can't arrive at a solution.
